In school we will:



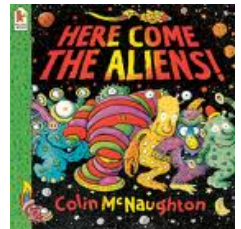
- we will learn about space

- build and construct with a range of objects and materials;
- use hands, tools and imagination when playing with the play dough.

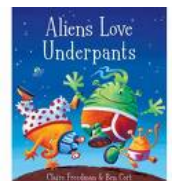

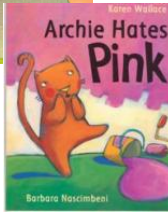
