English

What your child should know –

- The phoneme-grapheme correspondence for phase 2 & 3 phonics and begin to recognise phase 5 alternatives.
- How poetry, stories and non-fiction differ.
- How to orally compose a sentence.
- How to write phonetically plausible simple sentences.
- How to use a capital letter at the beginning of a sentence and a full stop at the end.
- A wider range of vocabulary.

Maths

What your child should know –

- How to use the part-whole model for addition.
- How to subtract by taking away and crossing out.
- How to accurately use the +, - and = symbols.
- How to find all eight facts within a fact family.
- How to recognise, name and sort 3D shapes.

Science

What your child should know –

- The main differences between carnivore, omnivore and herbivore.
- How to identify reptiles, mammals and amphibians.
- How to recognise some of the birds in the locality.
- How to sort by living, not living and never living.

Geography / History

What your child should know –

- The names of the four countries of the UK, their capital cities and the names of the different waters that surround the UK.
- How different their grandparent's childhood was compared to their own.
- How different things such as school, shops, food, holidays and celebrations were for their grandparents.

What your child should know –

- Who is a Christian and what do they believe?
- Know how Christians view God.
- Know several stories from the Bible.
- Know about symbols of Christianity.
- Know how Christians pray and give thanks.
- Know how people express their belief in God.

What your child should know –

- The piece of music 'The Carnival of the Animals' by the French composer Camille Saint-Saens.
- How to imitate and compare to musical sounds.
