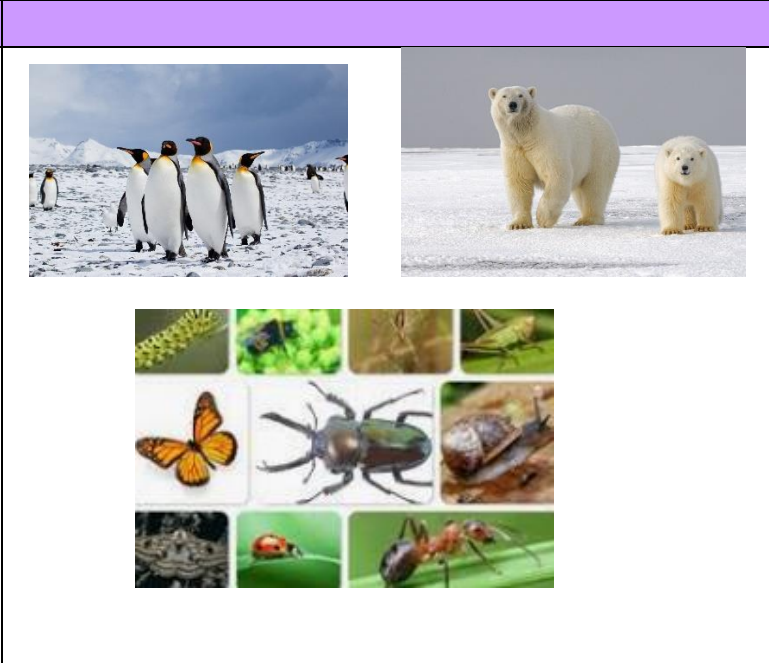
What do we know about the North and South Poles?

**Vocabulary**

**North Pole/Arctic** - The point that is furthest North on our Planet.

**South Pole/Antarctica** - The most Southern point of the Earth.

**Penguin** - A short-legged sea bird that cannot fly and is found in the colder regions of the Southern hemisphere.

**Polar Bear** - A large creamy, white meat-eating bear.

**Ice** - A solid form of water.

**Habitats** - A habitat is a place where living things naturally live.

**Mini beasts** - A small animal, like spiders, snails, slugs and beetles.

We will be reading *The Very Hungry Caterpillar*, *Lost and Found*, *Penguins*, *The Emperor's Egg* and *The Life Cycle of a Penguin*
