## Vocabulary

Autumn - Is the time of year when the hours of daylight are equal to the hours of darkness. When the leaves change colour and fall off the trees.

Winter - Is the coldest time of the year and comes after Autumn.

**Guy Fawkes-** A British soldier who was involved in a plan to blow up the Houses of Parliament.

Amelia Earhart – One of the most celebrated pilots of all time.

**Neil Armstrong** – The first human to walk on the moon during the Apollo 11 mission on  $20^{\rm th}$  July 1969.
