North Pole/Arctic - The point that is furthest North on our Planet.

South Pole/Antarctica – The most Southern point of the Earth.

Penguin – A short-legged sea bird that cannot fly and is found in the colder regions of the Southern hemisphere.

Polar Bear - Alarge creamy, white meat-eating bear.

Ice - A solid form of water.

Habitats - A habitat is a place where living things naturally live.

Mini beasts - A small animal, like spiders, snails, slugs and beetles.
