## <u>Communication and Language</u>

Learn to speak with more confidence during circle/carpet times. Listen to others in a small group. Follow simple instructions. Understand 'who', 'what' and 'where' in simple questions. Listen to and join in with stories.

## <u>Personal, Social and Emotional</u> <u>Development</u>

Separate from main carer with support. Classroom routines and expectations. Support children in making friends. Demonstrating positive relationships. Getting on and falling out. How to deal with anger/frustration, e.g. when someone has taken a toy.

#### <u>Physical Development</u>

## <u>Literacy</u>

Recognising their own name through use of coat peg and self-register cards. Listening and joining in with stories and rhymes. Phonics- Phase 1 – Environmental sounds. Experiment with mark making in a variety of ways.

# <u>Understanding the World</u>

Exploring interests in the lives of people who are familiar to them (talking about my family). Can talk about some of the things they have observed such as plants, animals, natural and found objects (Autumn walk)

## <u>Maths</u>

Counting rhymes. Encouraging children to use number names in their play. Use with 2d & 3d shapes in construction play.



# Expressive Arts and Design

Engage in imaginative role-play based on own first-hand experiences (home corner/small world...). Topic related – self-portraits using a variety of materials., Experimenting with paint to explore colour.
