#### Communication and Language

During this half term we will be encouraging children to; Be able to express a point of view and to debate when they disagree.

Start a conversation with an adult or a friend and continue it for many turns through Open-ended questions like "I wonder what would happen if....?

Use talk to organise themselves and their play: "Let's go on a bus... you sit there... I'll be the driver." by helping children to elaborate on how they are feeling.

### Personal, Social, and Emotional Development

During this half term we will be helping children to; Develop appropriate ways of being assertive. Talk with others to solve conflicts.

Talk about their feelings using words like 'happy', 'sad', 'angry' or 'worried'.

Understand gradually, how others might be feeling.

## Physical Development

This half term, we have a Dream Big Sports dance coach once a week.

Outside we have access to a range of bikes and scooters to develop gross motor skills.

We will also be continuing Dough Disco to develop fine motor skills.

# **Literacy**

Reading- We will be continuing with lots of fun activities to help children be able to retell stories using some story language. Children will also begin to recognise some initial letters and read some simple VC and CVC words.

Writing - Children should now be able to form the letters to write their own name. They will also begin to write some initial sounds and simple words Phonics - We will work on oral blending and segmenting

# Understanding the World

We will continue to look at the changing seasons with a focus on Summer and how to stay safe in the sun.

We will also look at understanding that dinosaurs were on the earth around 250 million years ago!

How the earth has changed since then and how we can look after and protect our environment.

We will continue to celebrate current festivals and special days including Father's Day.

#### Maths

Children should begin to solve real world mathematical problems with numbers up to 5. as we discuss mathematical ideas throughout the day.

We will be providing opportunities for children to experiment with their own symbols and marks as well as numerals.

They should also compare quantities using language: 'more than', 'fewer than' as we draw their attention to differences and changes in amounts.

#### Expressive Art & Design

Children will be given opportunities to engage in role play based on their experiences and learning.

Practise remembering and singing entire songs and Nursery Rhymes, produce Fossil prints, develop drawing techniques and Explore with different materials.
