Music - Musicians of Norden and Manchester

The children will learn about famous musicians from our local area of Norden and our nearest city; Manchester.

They will learn about the genre of Pop music, learn some of the local artists' songs and the types of bands they played in.

The children will then work in small groups to compose their own instrumental solo break for a song of their choice from the locally produced music studied, which they will then perform for their peers. The children will continue to develop their skills in performance, pitch, volume and simple notation.
