Nature of support 2016-2017

The funding received from the Pupil Premium Grant has been allocated in the following ways:

- Increased teaching assistant hours so that each class has a dedicated TA so that more intervention groups and support is given to the children in basic skills
- Funding for one-to-one tuition
- Funding for one-to-one support
- Providing free milk to those children receiving Free School Meals
- Providing free places at homework club throughout each week
- Providing free places on multi-activity and extra curriculum sessions each week
- Providing free places on residential visits in Y4, Y5 and Y6
- Providing free places on educational visits throughout the year
- Curriculum Focus of PPG spending
- Basic Skills – accelerating progress in Literacy and Numeracy.

Measuring the impact of PPG spending. We will track the progress and measure the attainment of

priority individuals and report on this at the end of the year.

September 2016 – July 2017

- English - Reading 74.1% made 4 or more points progress
- Writing 51.8% made 4 or more points progress
- Maths 48.1% made 4 or more points progress.

In school we expect all children to make 3 or more points progress each year. This shows good progress.
